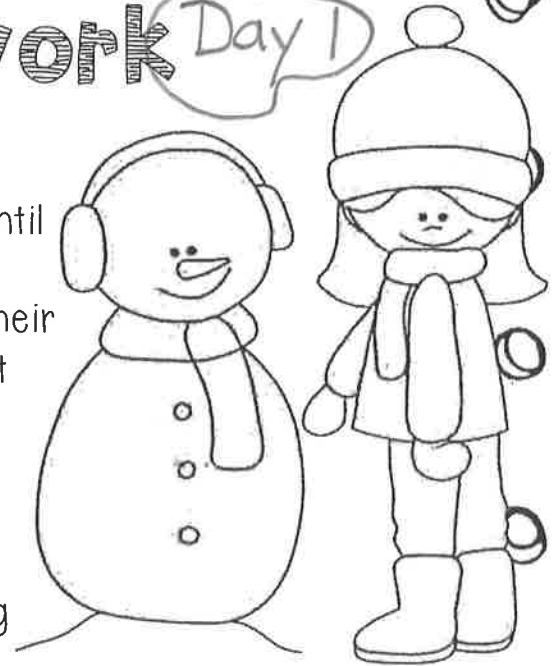

Snowman Teamwork Day 1

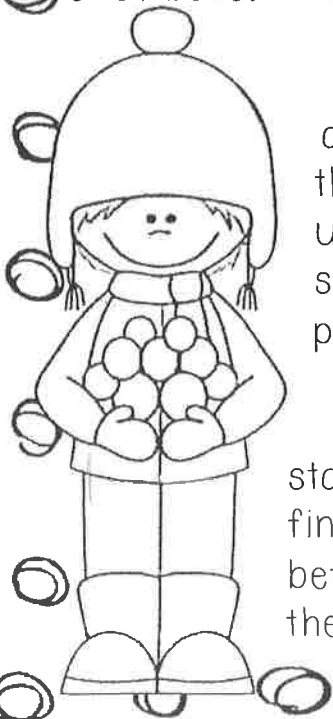
